Nancy Lee is the General Manager of the Multilateral Investment Fund at the Inter-American Development Bank. A laboratory for development, the MIF provides innovative support for micro, small, and medium enterprises and is the largest provider of technical assistance for private sector development in the region. From 2009-2011, she was Deputy Assistant Secretary for the Western Hemisphere at the U.S. Treasury Department, responsible for managing Treasury's engagement on economic and financial issues with Latin America, the Caribbean, and Canada. In 2008, she spent a year on sabbatical as a Visiting Fellow at the Center for Global Development in Washington, focusing on the future of regional integration in the Western Hemisphere. Before her sabbatical, she was Treasury's Deputy Assistant Secretary for Europe, Eurasia and the Western Hemisphere. Also at Treasury, she was the Director of the Office of Central and Eastern Europe, Director of the Office of Mideast and Central Asia, and Deputy Director of the Office of Asian and Near East Nations. Dr. Lee is a member of the Council on Foreign Relations and received the Meritorious Executive Presidential Rank Award in 2001. She holds a Ph.D. and an M.A. in economics from Tufts University and a B.A. in economics from Wellesley College.
